

### **HE WHAKAMĀRAMA**

Ruapani. Their children were Tamaterangi, Mākoro, Hingāngā, Pupuni and Pareroa and known as the five of Hinemanuhiri. The hapū of Hinemanuhiri thrived independently as well as together, drawing on their ancestral ties in times of need. The following marae and hapū descend from the union of Hinemanuhiri and Pūkaru

At its next elections Ngā Tokorima a Hinemanuhiri Trust will consist of seven marae appointments under the new representation model. The seven marae include: Rangiāhua, Pākōwhai, Whetūmārama, Maromahue, Rāmoto Kireara and Hineterā.

Some hapū are yet to indicate their interest in having representation on the trust and the opportunity is always available to them if and when they choose to do so.
